Board Meeting

The Board held its summer meeting on August 25, 2015. Highlights of the meeting include:

Auctions ~ Reay Cairns presented a summary of the auctions that took place during 2014-15 Club year.

- 1,585 lots were submitted and 1,075 sold.
- The total sale price was \$6,220.50.
- The average lot selling price was \$5.79.
- The Club's commission was \$565.30.

Membership ~ Chris Edwards presented membership stats as of the end of the Club year (August 31): renewed members 78; new members 16; closed album 1; making for a total membership of 93 as of the end of August.

Finances ~ Frank Alusio presented various financial reports as at the end of August 2015 including:

- Summary – The Club is solid financially.
- Statement of Income and Expense: Income of \$3,723.94, Expense of \$3,442.49, for a Surplus of \$381.45.
- 2015-16 Budget – Income and Expense are anticipated to be \$2,875.00
