As you are aware, the VGG Digital Resources Hub https://www.greenefoundation.ca/digital-resources
provides access to a variety of websites, digital newsletter archives, and online philatelic tools to aid one's BNA research. Limited resources for those who study other parts of the world are also available. One can spend many pleasurable hours perusing the links available. This week, I thoroughly enjoyed viewing a short video, **Dutch stamp collector**, linked to u-tube through this portal.

As well, a recent conversation with fellow philatelists introduced me to a digital portal through the **Collaboration Crew** whose stated purpose includes "Sharing, Learning, Growing Philately Together".

As well, the above link led me an overview of the Penny Black.



<u>WTSC BOARD REPORT TO THE MEMBERSHIP - WTSC Annual Exhibition changes - To further broaden opportunities for members to participate and experience the joy and fun of exhibiting, the following have been agreed to.</u>

- 1. Now that we are Chapter 148 of the ATA a new topical exhibit category/class will be added to the three existing exhibit classes.
- 2. A presentation on single page exhibiting will be made to the members at the next in-person meeting October 14th. Advantages of single page exhibiting will be highlighted, the process of creating a 1-page exhibit will be detailed, and changes to the scoring, paper size and opportunities for distance members will be noted.
- 3. As well, instead of happening in May, the WTSC Annual Exhibition will take place Tuesday, March 24th. This will enable WTSC's best 3 single frame exhibits to be selected to participate in the interclub "Garfield Portch Ontario Club Single Frame Competition" to be held at Hilton Mississauga/Meadowvale Hotel on April 11-12, 2026.




